What are your rights as an individual?

Any person for whom we have stored data has the following rights under GDPR law:

1. The right to be informed – being told what data we hold about you and what we do with it.
2. The right of access – being able to request a copy of your data we hold.
3. The right to rectification – being able to have inaccurate data corrected.
4. The right to erasure – being able to ask us to delete / destroy your data.
5. The right to restrict processing – being able to limit the amount or type of data used.
6. The right to data portability – requesting to move your data electronically to another business.
7. The right to object – being able to request us to stop using your data.
